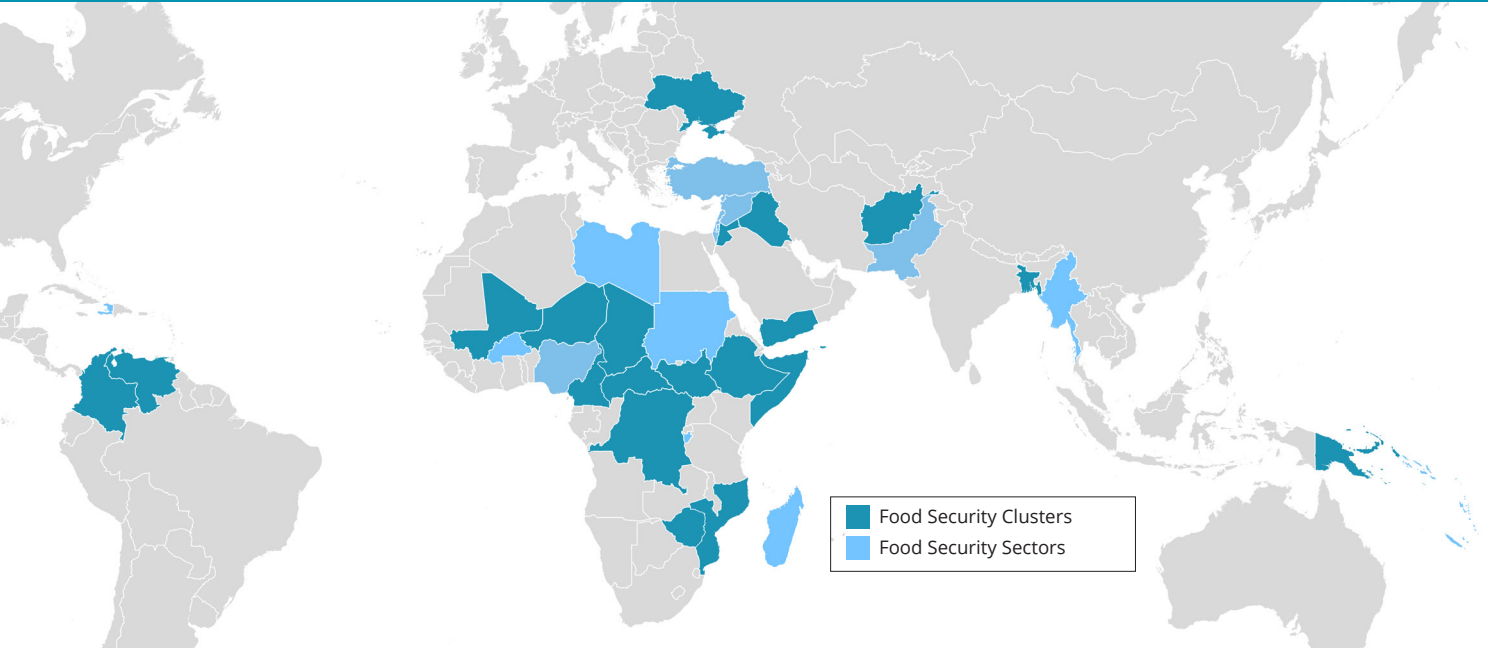


# Food Security Cluster

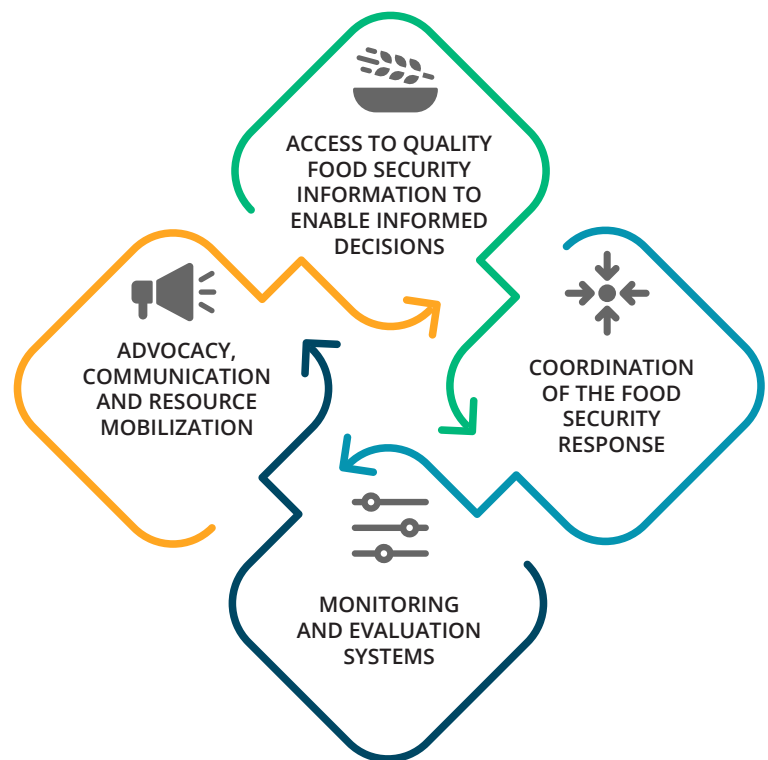


The Food Security Cluster (FSC) was established to coordinate response during a humanitarian crisis, addressing issues of food availability, access and utilization.

## What does the Food Security Cluster do?

The Food Security Cluster coordinates country-level food security response plans during humanitarian crises by:

- Ensuring there are no gaps or duplications in the response
- Providing information on food security to all partners
- Assisting partners in the preparation of country-level Humanitarian Needs Overviews (HNO) and Humanitarian Response Plans (HRP)
- Providing necessary information to lead agencies to be appropriately represented at the HCT.
